## The Scenario

- A user has a text message on his/her mobile phone that they wish translated
- The user forwards the message to a certain phone number (e.g. #2020)
- The message is translated via an MT server and the result sent back to the user's mobile phone



## **Motivation**

- Sakhr Software
  - Revenues per message translated
  - Develop a dialect preprocessor
- Mobile phone companies
  - Value added services to retain customers
  - Free service



#### **Data**

- English to Arabic (80%)
  - Over 50% Mobile advertisements & subscriptions
  - About 25% Dictionary, expressions, terminologies and short phrases
  - About 20% Chatting
  - About 5% Notifications for Bank accounts, Credit Cards,
     Prepaid cards....



#### **More Data**

- Arabic to English (20%)
  - Over 70% Chatting
  - 30% Dictionary, expressions, terminologies and short phrases
- Available in 11 countries
- Over 10,000 messages per day
